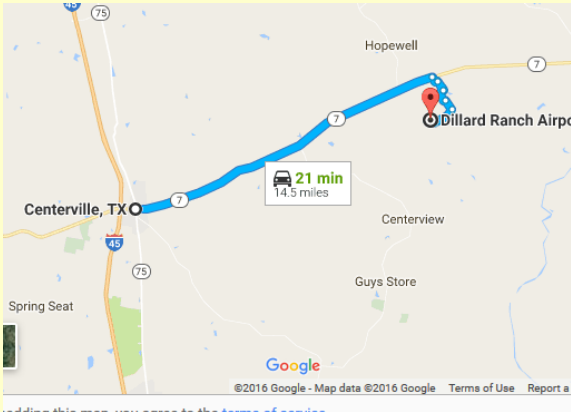


## Critters Lodge Info.
